

ATA Red Deer City Local Scholarship #60

Deadline to Apply:

Friday, May 7th by 4:00 p.m. – by email

Eligibility:

There are four scholarships available to any Red Deer School District Graduating High School Student. The first scholarship recognizes and supports the enhancement of the teaching profession. This scholarship, valued at \$2000, for a student who plans to enter a post-secondary program leading to a career in the teaching profession. The second scholarship, valued at \$2000, has been established to assist sons and daughters of ATA Local #60 members. Members of Local #60 include current members, members who retired with ATA Local #60, active substitute teachers, and those members on long-term disability leave. Eligible applicants must be graduating students who are going into a recognized post-secondary institution. A maximum one-year deferment is allowed. The third and fourth scholarship, valued at \$1500, will be available to two additional qualifying applicant at the discretion of the selection committee.

Value of Award:

Two scholarships of \$2000 are awarded, and two scholarships of \$1500

How to Apply:

Include the completed word-processed Scholarship Application detailing your co-curricular activities, outline some of your hobbies and interest and/or community involvement, the education route you plan to pursue in a post-secondary institution, outline any part-time jobs, volunteer work, or other experiences that have helped you to prepare for this career choice and briefly discuss why you have chosen this career and why you feel suited to it. The application must not exceed two pages in length. If you are apply for both \$2000 scholarships, please submit the two separate applications forms.

Attach all of your documents as a PDF file and submit as an attachment.
